

Dear Parish Family,

As we journey through this Lenten season, I've been reflecting on the story of the man born blind in John 9. The disciples saw his blindness and wondered who was to blame—whose sin caused this suffering? But Jesus turned their question upside down. "Neither this man nor his parents sinned," He said, "but this happened so that the works of God might be displayed in him" (John 9:3). Then, with a touch of mud and mercy, Jesus opened his eyes.

What strikes me is how Jesus didn't judge or condemn—he healed. He saw beyond the surface to reveal God's grace in an unexpected place. It's a reminder for us this Lent: God's love doesn't wait for us to be perfect. It meets us where we are, even in our struggles, and works through us in ways we might not expect.

So, let's follow Jesus together these final few weeks of Lent. Instead of pointing fingers or carrying heavy burdens of guilt, let's look for His light in the messiness of our lives and in each other. Maybe it's in a quiet moment of prayer, a kind word to someone hurting, or a step toward reconciliation. God's grace is at work in you. Follow his prompting as he invites us to trust Him more deeply.

This Lent, let's open our hearts to Jesus, the One who sees us fully and loves us completely. He's ready to do something beautiful through us. Will we let Him?
